







The common word in the first two statements is 'old' = 5

And the common word in the first and last statements is 'books' = 3

Now, the only word left in 1st statement is "are" = 2

The common word in the first two statements is 'is' = 4

And the common word in the first and last statements is 'blue' = 8

#### 7) Answer (A)

here we need to find the wrong number in 12439, 23549, 34659, 45769

as we will add the digits of every number

$$12439: 1 + 2 + 3 + 4 + 9 = 19$$

$$23549: 2+3+5+4+9=23$$



$$34659: 3+4+6+5+9=27$$

$$45769: 4+5+7+6+9=31$$

As we can see that in very case the sum of digits of number is a prime number except in case of 34659 and hence 34659 is the odd one out

#### 8) Answer (A)

Series: Lily, Daisy, Datura,?

The number of letters in the words are in increasing order = 4, 5, 6

So, the next word will contain 7 letters, and among the options the correct word = Jasmine
